

How do I know if an item is available for circulation?

An item's **Status** will indicate whether it is available for circulation or if it currently checked out. For example, the **Status** of John Harr's, *A Civil Action*, shows that it is available for circulation and is located in the General Collection.

Is there a way to check the due dates for the items I have checked out?

Due dates are displayed by clicking the **My Checkouts** tab under the **My Accounts** dropdown menu in the Gavel. The username and password defaults to your Student ID. Once you are logged in, you will see the titles of the items you have checked out as well as the due dates for each item on the right hand side of the screen.

If an item is available electronically, how do I access it?

The Sol Blatt Jr. Law Library provides 24/7 access to our electronic resources from both on and off campus. When searching EDS, you will be prompted to click the link to access an electronic resource. From off campus, you will first need to authenticate for access, i.e. enter a username and password, but you should only have to authenticate one time per session.

What is the Gavel, and how does it compare to EDS?

The Gavel is the Law Library's catalog. It is accessible from both on and off campus by clicking the Library dropdown on the Charleston School of Law's web page. It can also be accessed on the Law Library's main page by clicking either the **Search the Library Catalog** or the **Research Resources** links.



The Gavel is a great tool to use when searching for a specific legal treatise, study aid, or class reserve item. Keep in mind, though, that EDS incorporates all of the results found in the Gavel while including additional results from our databases that cannot be accessed through the Gavel.
