I realize that if I drop classes or cease enrollment, fail to enroll in an eligible term and hours for summer aid, and/or fail to meet credit requirements for federal loans, I may have my financial aid and loans revised based on my actual dates of attendance, and it may create a balance owed to the Law School. *If I receive a loan and then I am placed on academic probation, disqualification and/or fail to meet satisfactory academic progress, I understand I am not eligible for the loan, and any funds received will have to be paid back immediately.*

The chart above should assist you in determining the amount of loans you will need to borrow for Summer 2018. The first column, entitled “Number of Credit Hours,” is a list of the number of hours you are taking over Summer 2018. The second column, entitled “Tuition Costs,” is the amount of tuition costs that will appear on your Charleston School of Law ledger. The third column is entitled “M1 & S1 Max Loan Eligibility.” If you are taking classes in both Maymester and Summer 1 sessions at Charleston School of Law, please use this column. The fourth column is entitled “M1 & S2 Max Loan Eligibility.” Please use this column if you are only taking classes in Summer 2 session and Maymester. The fifth column is entitled “S1 Max Loan Eligibility.” Please use this column if you are taking classes in Summer 1 session, and not in Maymester.

**Remember: Students only taking classes in Maymester at Charleston School of Law are not eligible for financial aid. Classes in sessions M2 and S3 are not eligible for aid. Classes in S4 are only aid eligible in conjunction with a S1 session class.**

**The figures in the chart are only applicable at Charleston School of Law. Study abroad opportunities have different costs and eligibility amounts.**
