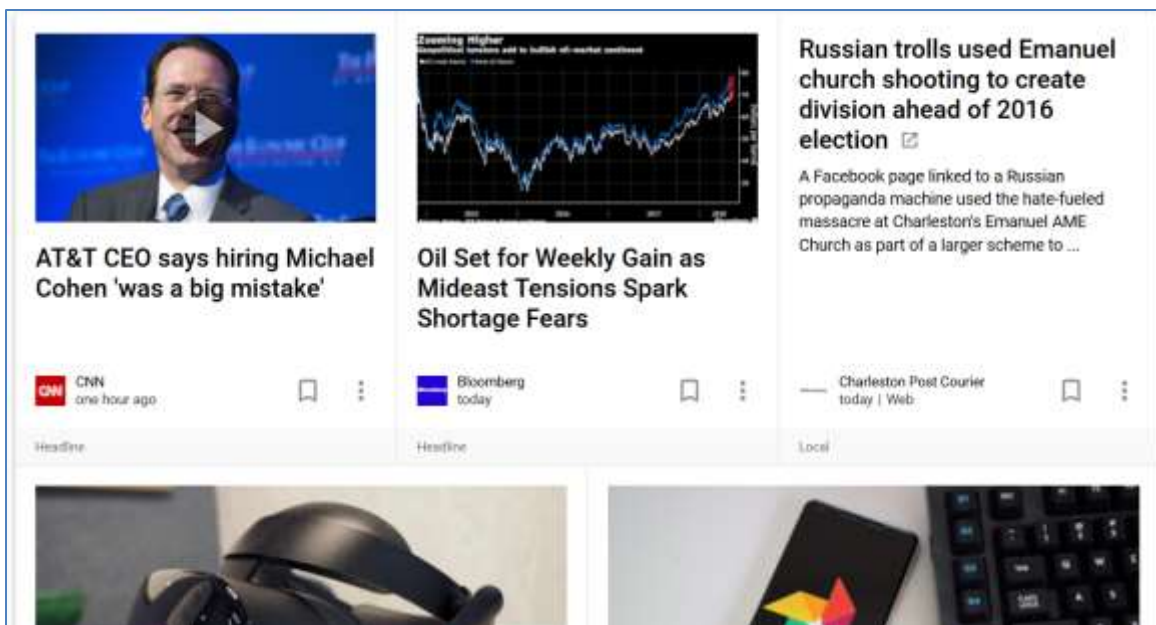
URL of the Month

This month’s URL of the Month is a news aggregator site called Google Play Newsstand. It is a free service provided by Google that collects and displays news articles from a large variety of news websites. By personalizing your news feed, Google Play Newsstand is able to provide more tailored news to you instead of the random information blast that you would normally receive from a news site.

You can use Google Play Newsstand without signing into a Google Account but it works best if you are signed in. In addition to the website link, Google provides app versions for both iOS and Android users.
